Ragging is the term used for the so called "initiation ritual" practiced in higher education institutions. Ragging involves abuse, humiliation, or harrassement of new entrants or junior students by senior students. It often takes a Malignant form wherein the new comers may be subjected to psychological and physical torture. In 2009, the UGC of India imposed regulations upon Indian universities to help curb ragging and launched a tollfree hepline for anti-raging.

As per the UGC Regulations 2009 and Supreme Court guidelines, ragging is a serious crime due to which the morale of the newly admitted students breaks down and the students are subjected to various types of physical, mental and social abuse. Anti-ragging cell has been constituted in the college to prevent ragging, whose function is to ensure that the students of the college follow the rules of anti-ragging and to monitor and prevent criminal acts related to ragging.
