

7.2. Best Practice -2

1. Title of the Practice: *“SankalpSaamudayikSewaKa”(Village Adoption Programme)*

2. Objectives of the Practice: India lives in its village, said Mahatma Gandhi, Indicating that if we want the development of our country we should focus on the village. The ministry of human resource development (MHRD) has launched a programme called Unnat Bharat Abhiyan to connect higher education Institution with local community to address the development challenges through appropriate methods. Therefore, under this campaign the college has also adopted a village, named Jurrampur, and set the following objectives in this direction:

1. To promote the students, staff members and community to understand the community's life.
2. To understand themselves in relation to their community.
3. To identify the needs and problems of the community and the solution to them.
4. To acquire leadership qualities and a democratic attitude.
5. To create awareness about programmes and schemes run by the government for their development.
6. To encourage community for its peace, harmony and national integration.
7. To Focus on women empowerment by highlighting issues relating them.
8. To create linkage between the students of college and community school's children.
9. To aware villagers about sustainability of traditions and culture and also promote them to conserve it.
10. Promoting for green belt and green cover by planting more plants and conserve them.

11. To create awareness about skills based education and career opportunities.

12. To aware and sensitize rural people to conserve water and energy.

13. To spread awareness for organic farming and food processing.

14. To promote faculty members and students to identify the research areas and scope.

3. The Context: Sankalp: Samudayikuttradayitvka” as the name indicates, that the aim of the program is to create sensitivity, awareness and feeling of responsibility among faculty and students towards community.

4. The Practice: By this programme we are advocating the villagers lead change in the village, where we can try to address the issues of education for all, health care, sanitation, sustainable livelihoods, community infrastructure development and gender equality etc. we believe to bring change in life style by promoting values based traditional Indian system and sustainable aspects of our culture.

The college despite its limited resources made important efforts to fulfil its objectives related to community. A survey has conducted to choose the village. An inaugural program “ChhachPar Charcha” organized to discuss the programmes in details with BDO, Gram Pradhan and villagers. In this talk BDO Shri Deepak Kumar appreciated the initiative taken by the college and also suggests some areas to work. After the talk, a proposal of the programmes has been decided and assigns a programme to each department. On 9 April 2022, a program on “Water Conservation and Energy Conservation”, organized by the departments of Physics and Botany in which students and teachers aware the villagers to save water and energy.

On 23 April 2022, an event on “Conservation of Folk Culture” was organized by the departments of history and music. The aim of the programme is to aware the community to conserve the folk culture.

On 2 May 2022, a program on “ Aaokahanievm Khel kemadhyam se seekhe”, was organized by the department of Hindi and English in SDK high school, Jurrampur. In the events teachers and students of the college interact with the students of the school in very interesting way. On 2 May 2022,dental check-up camp was held to spread the awareness about dental care and hygiene. On 13 August 2022, a program on “ TirangaYatra and Plantation” under the banner of AzadikaAmritMahotsav , was conducted in the village. The aim of the programme is to spread the feeling of affection for the nation. After the TirangaYatra, plants were planted in the school to encourage the community to environment conservation.

5. Evidences of success:

1. The students and teachers are able to make a harmonious bond with community. Students are aware about their way of life, their problems and connect themselves as a member of that community.
2. Students learnt to established rapport with various categories of people live in village.
3. Students and teachers are able to spread awareness about education, health and hygiene, environment conservation, gender equality etc. and also identified the problems related to them.
4. Teachers and students identified the some areas of social survey research.
5. It was a matter of great pleasure for the college when students connect themselves with the children and staff of the school.

6. Problems encountered and Recourses required:

1. Village Adoption Program is a self-financed program of the college, so there was a financial problem to conduct the programmes.
2. Due to a very hectic academic session, classes, exams and other assignment, it was tedious for the departments and teachersto manage time to conduct programs.

3. Sometime villagers are not ready to listen and attend the talk/walk/workshop or camps were organized. In such situation we had have to take local support to convince them to attend the program.
